

Wisut Ponnimit solo exhibition "Mamuang chan na ja!"

Wisut Ponnimit, the Thai artist and cartoonist, and well-known for his nick name "Tam" will hold an exhibition "Mamuang chan na ja!".

"Chan" is a kind of title for girls in Japanese. To those who will know the Mamuang for the first time, we will introduce Mamuang with new drawings and print works. Wisut himself will appear at the exhibition and will take part in the related events during the exhibition.

【Who is Mamuang?】

Mamuang is a character Wisut created during two-and-a-half-year since 2003 in Japan. The origin of the name comes from her head's shape like mango. And 'mamuang' is mango in Thai. She is an innocent and lovely girl who cries when she feels sad, and laughs when she is fun. As Mamuang has been used for several products or companies such as LINE stickers or Japanese fashion brand "Ne-net," she is renowned in Asia including Thailand and Japan.

【Wisut Ponnimit's profile】

Wisut is Thai manga and animation artist living in Bangkok. After debuted with his first manga in Thailand in 1998, he came to study in Japan in 2003 and afterwards he has published his manga works such as "Blanco" and "Mamuang" in Japan.
