## **Nature Explorer: Klong Kon Mangrove Conservation Center**

The Klong Kon Mangrove Conservation Center, located in Klong Kon Subdistrict, is a tourism destination aimed at conserving mangrove forests. It was initiated in 1991 by Mr. Paiboon Rattanapongthara (known as "Phuyai Chong") and the local community, who came together to plant mangrove trees in the Klong Kon area.

Historically, the mangrove forest had been heavily encroached upon for shrimp farming, resulting in the loss of over 2,000 rais of mangrove land. Today, community groups have formed to organize conservation tourism activities for general tourists, groups, and interested individuals. Activities include planting mangroves, paddleboarding in the mangroves, searching for clams, learning conservation methods from local experts, and taking boat tours to observe the mangrove ecosystem, including mangrove forests and long-tailed macaques, as well as experiencing the lifestyles of local fishermen, among others.

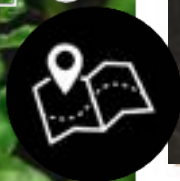
