The natural tie-dye group in the Kiriwong community, a
place where colors from nature are applied to fabric.





Learning About Natural Dyeing

Participants will engage in activities to learn about natural tie-dyeing, which is considered an art form through nature. They will use materials such as mangosteen leaves, stink bean pods, rambutan husks, and young coconut husks, starting from the initial processes to the final tie-dyeing. This includes preparing the raw materials and creating a piece of fabric or clothing.

Experiences

Participants will gain knowledge about the different colors obtained from nature and where each color comes from, as well as insights into the tie-dyeing process from skilled instructors.


Experience the cotton weaving that represents the identity of the Sakon Nakhon people and learn to create indigo-dyed fabrics in the traditional style of the Nongsan community

Activity: Indigo-Dyed Silk Weaving

Participants will learn how to weave indigo-dyed silk from local artisans, exploring the production process for indigo fabric and the traditional methods of dyeing

Experience Gained

Participants will gain knowledge about indigo weaving for practical use and how to develop products that generate income for the community



Activity: Indigo Harvesting

Participants will visit indigo gardens and learn about the harvesting process to utilize the indigo plants

Experience

Participants will learn the steps involved in caring for indigo, harvesting it, and the benefits derived from its various parts







Cotton Spinning, Weaving, and Indigo Dyeing

The community creates indigo-dyed fabrics from natural indigo plants, using traditional methods. The process of producing indigo-dyed cloth is intricate and requires both time and dedication to achieve the natural color

Participants will learn how to produce cotton, from its cultivation to the weaving process, gaining insights into traditional techniques and practices






