Farming Class at Sampran Garden: Learning Agriculture Through Real Experience

Suan Sampran is an inspiring space for learning aimed at sustainable development, featuring a variety of organic tourism activities amidst a beautiful garden atmosphere infused with Thai culture. It offers knowledge and health activities, making it an ideal place for learning and embracing new experiences.

Located along the Tha Chin River in Nakhon Pathom, Sampran Garden is just an hour's drive from Bangkok. It stands out for promoting sustainable agriculture and preserving traditional Thai culture. With over 130 rai of land, the garden offers a range of activities suitable for children, allowing them to engage in hands-on experiences in a natural environment surrounded by diverse trees, flower gardens, fruit trees, herbs, restaurants, and educational and recreational areas.

The garden emphasizes the connection and value chain of its socially responsible business model in partnership with local farmers, illustrating the link between organic farming and the creation of a circular economy. In the organic fields, a circular economy is naturally fostered; for example, farmers raise ducks and chickens, using their manure to create fertilizer. Household food waste is also converted into fertilizer, which is then recycled for use in the fields, reducing costs and promoting self-sufficiency.








Making Bio-Products from Natural Ingredients in the Area






